The Needham Community Farm has had a successful year. We opened our Community Garden Beds, were the recipient of a grant from the Healy-Driscoll Administration to purchase a new electric van, and received three awards. The most notable of the awards we received was the Impact Award from the Charles River Chamber of Commerce. All of this was accomplished on top of our yearly operations which include: donating produce, hosting hundreds of volunteers of all ages, and educating our community about sustainable growing practices.

Running a small nonprofit farm is a team effort. We could not have accomplished our work without the dedication and passion from our farm staff Allie Comet and Ceilidh Peden-Spear, our Development Director; Courtney Sodano and many volunteers. Our Board of Directors continue to provide strategic guidance and hands-on involvement with projects and programs.

Registration for a 2024 Community Garden Bed: *Coming Soon!*



After a successful first season, we will be opening 2024 Community Garden Bed registration in January 2024!

Registration includes:

- Season lease of a raised garden bed. All beds are 4' x 12'. 135 beds have a height of 22" and 15 beds have a height of 30" to accommodate those with accessibility issues.
- Use of supplies, including hose, tools, and wheel barrow.
- All beds come complete with compost/soil from Black Earth Compost.
- Unlimited access to Community Bed area, including picnic tables.
